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**Market Table** 54 Carmine St  
at Bedford St; 212-255-2100

The once eccentric Shopsins space in the Village has gone "barnyard chic"—wooden tables, wide windows and a huge yellow awning. And its burger? Eight ounces of a 50-50 sirloin-and-brisket blend grilled and topped with white cheddar, house-made pickles, caramelized onions, lettuce and tomato—all on an herb-and-roasted-garlic bun.
